2019 is shaping up to be an exciting year for The Village in light of **Multiply**. Your support has allowed us to invest in missions around the world and make great strides toward commissioning healthy autonomous churches here in DFW and beyond. Multiply is: transitioning our remaining campuses into autonomous churches, planting churches, and increasing our local and global missions involvement.

MULTIPLY AT THE CAMPUSES

We long to see the name of Jesus lifted high, both in our local area and across the globe. Each of The Village's five campuses have been laboring toward that goal, and there is still plenty of work to do. Here's what's been happening across our church:

Flower Mound

While we look toward the future of Multiply and the eventual transition of The Village's four other campuses, the Flower Mound campus has been considering what it will look like to replant as a local church. With a vision of increasing investment in making holistic disciples, showing hospitality to our community, and training up and sending out missionaries and church planters, the Flower Mound elders located a piece of property near the current campus where a new building could be designed that would provide an opportunity to better realize our mission. On March 31, Covenant Members in Flower Mound voted to approve the purchase of this property by a margin of 93%.

Plano

The Plano campus has been preparing for transition for a while now, and officially voted in January to become a local church later in the year. In April, Plano moved to local preaching that is more contextualized to their people and area. In August, the Plano campus will transition fully to Citizens Church, a local, autonomous body.

Transition is fast approaching for the Dallas Northway campus as well. In August,

Shea Sumlin was welcomed as the new campus pastor, and the path toward becoming a local autonomous church became clear. The campus transitioned to local preaching in January, taking a big step toward autonomy. On April 7, Covenant Members in Dallas voted on a transition that will take place later in the year, when they would become Northway Church. This vote passed with over **97%** approval. **Fort Worth**
